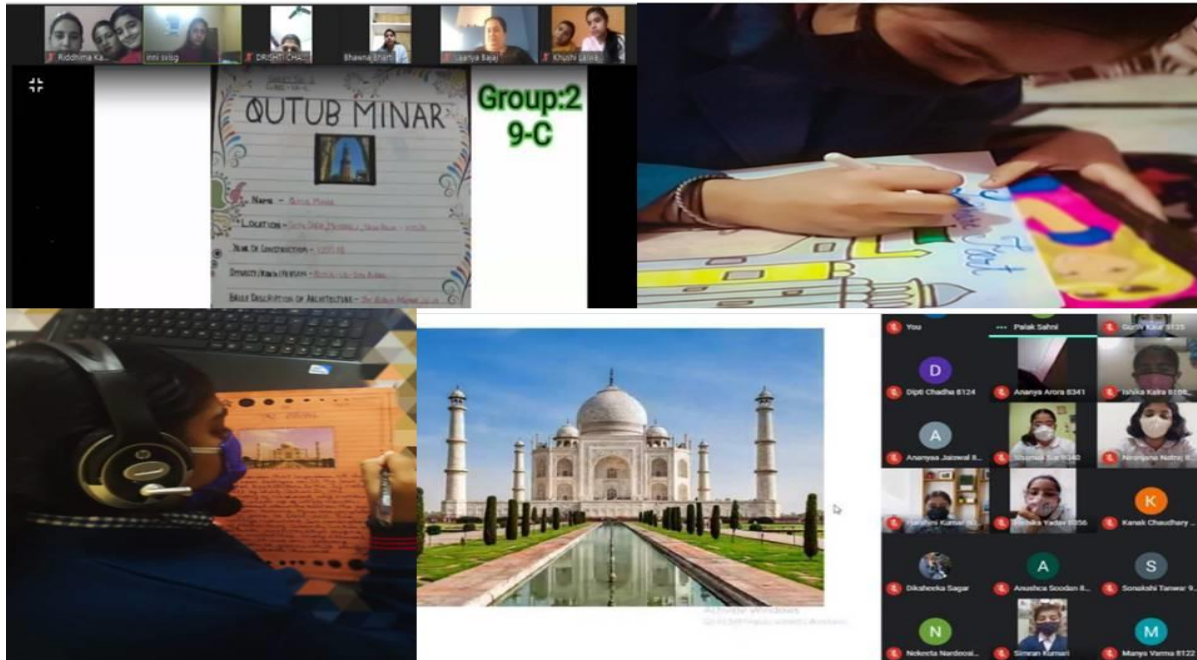


INTER- CLASS SCRAPBOOK MAKING AND ‘e’ DISPLAY ACTIVITY
